"Kareno founder Kamal became inspired by my art and created a luxury fashion brand. I continue giving Kamal my new painting patterns and he incorporates them into his inspirational designs."

Are there any artists that left a deep impression that played a major influence on your growth as an artist?

"Mainly my mom. She has been my true inspiration. My mom encouraged me and nurtured me throughout my journey. And of course my dad, who gave me his warm-hearted support."

What are your future goals?

"I'd like to study art more, learn more, and grow more. And my wish is, to make even more people happy with my art."

How has your style changed since you first began painting? And are there any other mediums you're looking to explore further in the future?

"As I grew up , I explored different brush techniques that gave me the results I wanted. A few years ago, when I began using oils, my style changed, and my technique changed with it. Lately I've been enjoying oil pastels."



How would you describe your creative process?
